

- Graduates can progress on to TU957 (Level 8) BSc Programme (one year full-time).

## **Programme Delivery Strategies**

All programmes are delivered with a mix of interactive on-line delivery, block delivery and Face2Face tutorials and workshops in the new state-of-the-art 'Central Quad' building at TU Dublin Grangegorman Campus. Face2Face classes, block workshops and tutorials will be scheduled on Tuesday and Thursday evenings for all programmes. Other blocks of delivery will be scheduled during both semesters with the students depending on the module.

The Hospitality sector has undoubtedly been deeply affected by Covid-19. However, industry experts expect that the sector will quickly return to form with a general resurgence in demand for all services within the sector. ## Can I progress further after completing a Level 6 or 7?

Students who successfully graduate from the Higher Certificate Programmes (Level 6) may progress directly to the 3rd year of the BA in Hospitality Management Studies (TU150), and also to other further training and education awards at Level 7 of the NFQ.

Students who successfully graduate from the BA Hospitality Management may progress to the one-year add-on programme: TU957 BSc Level 8 (Honours) in Hospitality Management, and to other further training and education awards at level 8 of the NFQ.

On successful completion of a Level 8 degree, there are further opportunities for students to progress to a Master's Degree at Level 9 and also to PhD Level 10.
